Estuary Restoration Act	\$100,000 to \$1 million	Funds estuary habitat restoration, with a focus on projects that address projected climate change impacts. http://www.era.noaa.gov/information/funding.html	March 10 2011
The Nature Conservancy Community-based Matching Grants	\$25,000 to \$85,000	Funds marine and coastal habitat restoration projects that benefit fish and shellfish around the coastal U.S. The applicant should be a TNC local chapter, or working in close coordination with a local chapter.	April 1, 2011
FishAmerica Foundation Grants	\$10,000 to \$75,000	Funds on-the-ground marine and anadromous fish habitat restoration projects that benefit recreationally fished species. http://www.fishamerica.org/grants/	May 16, 2011
Puget Sound Nearshore Partnership	\$25,000 to \$150,000	Funds the restoration of ecosystem processes that create and sustain marine shorelines, estuaries, intertidal and shallow subtidal habitats throughout Puget Sound. Funds are allocated through the Estuary and Salmon Restoration Program and solicitation. http://pugetsoundnearshore.org/esrp.htm	Fall 2011
NOAA Marine Debris Prevention and Removal Project Grants	\$15,000- \$250,000	Funds individual grass-roots marine debris prevention and removal projects that benefit coastal habitat like wetlands and estuaries, as well as fisheries, marine mammals, and sea turtles. http://www.habitat.noaa.gov/funding/marinedebris.html	Fall 2011
NOAA Open Rivers Initiative	\$100,000 to \$3 million	Funds the removal of obsolete dams and other stream barriers to improve fish habitat, enhance public safety, and boost local economies. http://www.habitat.noaa.gov/funding/ori.html	Fall 2011
American Rivers River Restoration Grants	\$50,000 to \$100,000	Funds dam and barrier removal projects that restore and improve migratory fish habitat. http://www.americanrivers.org/noagrants	Winter 2011
Ecotrust Whole Watershed Restoration Initiative	\$20,000 - \$100,000	Funds projects that aim to restore the natural functions of whole watersheds and amplify community-based partnerships focused on the strategic restoration of Pacific salmon and steelhead ecosystems. http://www.ecotrust.org/wwri/	Winter 2011
NOAA National and Regional Partnership Grants	\$500,000- \$1,000,000	Funding available for multi-year national and regional habitat restoration partnerships (such as The Nature Conservancy or American Rivers, listed above) that will result in implementation of a wide-range of habitat restoration projects. http://www.habitat.noaa.gov/funding/partnerships.html	Fall 2012
